



Innovation Corridor Requirements

The **Biotech 2010** Innovation Corridor provides a unique opportunity for presenters to share their research, aimed at solving problems and addressing needs, with industry leaders focused on key issues facing the bioscience industry. The objective of the session is to foster world-class collaborations among academia, early-stage research organizations, and industry.

Topics:

The poster should describe your research or development efforts to provide bioscience-based solutions to unmet needs in areas that can include, for example, therapeutics, medical devices, diagnostics, and green technologies. The poster should also include citations listing presentations and publications.

Abstract Requirements:

- Completion of the Poster Abstract Submission Form
- All abstract submissions should be structured to include:
 - Title
 - Author(s)
 - Company/Institution
 - E-mail address
 - Problem or unmet need
 - Proposed Solution
 - Potential Commercial Markets
 - IP Status
 - Potential Collaborators
 - Next Steps
- The abstract must fit within one 8.5"x 11" page (Electronic submission using Microsoft Word or Adobe Acrobat PDF is recommended)
- Embedded (not linked) tables and or graphics may be included as long as the abstract does not exceed the 8.5" x 11" page limitation

Poster Guidelines:

- All posters will be displayed on either Wednesday, October 27 or Thursday, October 28. Posters will be set up and completely dismantled by authors. Selected posters will be given one time slot for presentation.
- Posters must be set up 30 minutes in advance of the designated time slot.

- Please bring only items that can be mounted on poster board. No electrical projection capabilities will be available. All items for posting must be prepared in advance. Graphic supplies will not be available.
- Posters will be affixed to a display board. Each poster should be constructed to fit into the allotted space of four feet by six feet (4'h x 6'l). Authors are responsible for supplying their own materials for mounting on poster board. (Pins or thumb tacks recommended).
- A space assignment number will be given to all poster participants. Please set your display up on the poster board with your assignment number on it. Presenters will be required to be present at their poster station during the time slot designated for their poster's display.

Abstract Submission Procedure:

- Poster topics and abstracts can be submitted by e-mail to **management@biotech2010.org**.
- Please e-mail **management@biotech2010.org** or call 800.273.0369 with any questions.
- Authors should bring their poster content material to **Biotech 2010** and will be responsible for mounting their display.

A panel of judges will conduct a peer-review of all submissions and determine acceptance into the Innovation Corridor. Your abstract may be published in a handout for **Biotech 2010** even if it is not chosen to be presented as part of the Innovation Corridor.

Registration:

There will be a \$100 registration fee for one presenter per poster if you are accepted to present. This registration fee has been offset by the generous support of AstraZeneca. This fee will allow you to participate in the Innovation Corridor and attend the full day's events **only** on the day that you are scheduled to present.
